- ◆ **The Purpose of Asian Bible School:** IGo Asian Bible School is designed as a place for Asian Christians to experience learning and fellowship under the instruction of Bible teachers.
- ◆ **General Information:** Asian Bible School is a school that runs for 3 weeks at the Institute for Global Opportunities (IGo) in Chiang Mai, Thailand. There are 3 classes offered each year. All classes are in **English** and students must have a good grasp of the English language in order to successfully complete the course. Students are given a certificate after completing a 3-week training successfully. Students will receive a diploma after completing ABS in three different years.
- ◆ **Dates for Asian Bible School 2024:** July 22 - August 9
- ◆ **Arriving and Departing:** Students should arrive in Chiang Mai, Thailand on July 21 and leave by August 10 or 11. The airport code for Chiang Mai is CNX.
- ◆ **Price for tuition, room and board:** \$100 USD per person
- ◆ **Classes offered in 2024:**
 - ◆ **Ephesians:** Our individual and corporate identity as believers is a major part of the book of Ephesians. From personal salvation we become incorporated into the family of God. Therefore, this class will strive to strengthen our interpersonal relationships in the family and the church.
 - ◆ **Team Dynamics:** The crux of mission work often falls back to interpersonal relationships. Missionaries must learn to resolve conflict and function as a team.
 - ◆ **Missiology:** Every missionary develops a theological and philosophical model for their mission work. From this they formulate processes of contextualization to avoid syncretism. Therefore, a biblical methodology is essential.
- ◆ **Dress Code and Other Information:**
 - ◆ Modest, loose-fitting clothing for all students
 - ◆ **Men:** Button-shirts in class. Full-length pants for class and recreation nights.
 - ◆ **Women:** Dresses, skirts/blouses, or traditional cultural feminine clothing for women.
 - ◆ Bedding and towels are provided.
- ◆ **Visa Information:**
